

Radiographic Consult


Radiographic interpretation of film, digital radiography, and computed radiology are available for veterinary clinics in and out of our service areas.

We are able to accept images submitted by postal mail, email or using our DICOM server which can be accessed through our website at: lakelandvetimaging.com.


DIAGNOSTIC ULTRASOUND IMAGING

Ultrasound is an advanced diagnostic imaging tool used in conjunction with other diagnostic tests. Though primarily used to image pathology of the abdomen, ultrasound can also provide imaging diagnosis of mediastinal/pleural/lung disease in the thorax, thyroid/parathyroid disease, ocular and body wall masses.
